| <p>Attendance policy</p> | <p>Attendance is a mandatory component of assessment. For objective reasons (for example, illness, employment, international internship), training can take place on-line according to the agreement with the course instructor.</p> |
| <p>Assessment policy</p> | <p>Cheating during control works and preparation for final test, examinations and other inspection forms are forbidden (including with the use of mobile devices); conditions of admission to final control: - attendance (or work-out) of all classes; - presence of lecture notes or self-preparation; - active participation in practical trainings (answering questions); - timely performance of home tasks on independent work; - preparation for final tests and practical tasks according to the module. - mobile devices are allowed to be used only when preparing practical tasks during the class.</p> |

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| Deadline and course retake policy | The works, which seem to violate the terms of checking without valid reasons, are estimated at a lower rating (75% of the possible maximum number of scores); the conversion of modules is carried out with the permission of the dean if there are valid reasons (e.g.: illness, participation in competitions, conferences, etc.) and is estimated without lowering of the score. |
| Assessment appeals policy | The results of the module and semester assessment are subject to appeal. A student must lodge an appeal to the director/dean on the day of certification or after announcing the results, but no later than the next working day. The appeal commission is established by the director/dean's order. The appeal commission's decision may change the grade in case of violations revealed during the attestation. |

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| Academic integrity policy | <p>Participants must complete all tasks according to the course requirements independently. Participants are not allowed to cheat during the written module or summative test. The assignments should not contain plagiarism, facts of fabrication, falsification, cheating. Manifestations of other types of academic dishonesty determined by the Academic Integrity policy are also unacceptable. If a teacher reveals violations of academic integrity by students during the course, the former have the right to take one of the following actions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to reduce points by up to 40% for practical assignments; - to give recommendations for improving and resubmitting mandatory homework assignments with the reduction of points by up to 25%; - to not accept mandatory homework assignments without the right to resubmit; - set a date for retaking the written module or the summative test with a reduction of points by up to 15%; - to not allow to retake the written module or the summative test. |
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
