POLICIES	
Attendance policy	The student must attend 100% of practical classes. In case of skipping classes, the student must work off the missed class in accordance with the schedule of work, approved by the department in the presence of the relevant order of the dean's office.

Assessment policy	When mastering materials to the module, the student is assigned a maximum of 5 points for the skin practical employment (the rating is displayed in the traditional 4 points rating system). For example, the arithmetic mean of the student's success is improved. The maximum number of scores, as a student can reject it on practical employment, stretching out the initial rock - 110. The number of scores of a student to go for the formula 100 multiplied by the arithmetic mean and turn by 5. For writing "5 to be mischievous: 5 "- 4 points," 3 "- 3 points," 2 "- 0 points. For the abstract of the presentation: "5" - 5 points, "4" - 4 points, "3" - 3 points, "2" - 0 points. For the abstract, a student can reject a maximum of 10 points, the minimum required score is 6. The minimum number of points is 6 points. The maximum number of points for the actual performance of the student is 120. The student will be allowed to the differentiated hall for the screening of the initial programs, if, for the time being, I will take the number of points for the first time: 72 hours. Practical organization of the course is carried out according to the start of the initial course. A student can get a loan if he scored at least
Deadlines and course retake policy	 start of the initial course. A student can get a loan if he scored at least 48 points out of 80. The grand ball for discipline cannot exceed 200 points. In case of unsatisfactory result, the student has the right to reassign the differentiated test twice - the first time to the teacher appointed by the head of the department, the second - to the commission created by the dean's office. The transfer of credit is carried out according to a separate schedule, which is approved by the dean's office. Students who fail to take the test without good reason are considered to have received an unsatisfactory grade. The student's refusal to perform the control task is certified as an unsatisfactory answer. The student has the right to receive an explanation of the grade obtained.
Assessment appeals policy	The results of the module and semester assessment are subject to appeal. A student must lodge an appeal to the director/dean on the day of certification or after announcing the results, but no later than the next working day. The appeal commission is established by the director/dean's order. The appeal commission's decision may change the grade in case of violations revealed during the attestation.
Academic integrity policy	Participants must complete all tasks according to the course requirements independently. Participants are not allowed to cheat during the written module or summative test. The assignments should not contain plagiarism, facts of fabrication, falsification, cheating. Manifestations of other types of academic dishonesty determined by the Academic Integrity policy are also unacceptable. If a teacher reveals violations of academic integrity by students during the course, the former have the right to take one of the following actions: - to reduce points by up to 40% for practical assignments; - to give recommendations for improving and resubmitting mandatory homework assignments with the reduction of points by up to 25%; - to not accept mandatory homework assignments without the right to resubmit; - set a date for retaking the written module or the summative test with a reduction of points by up to 15%; - to not allow to retake the written module or the summative test.
